FOOD & DRINKS

If you're a foodie and want to explore the Bavarian palate, then let's go to the "**Lindwurmstüberl**", which has made a name for itself in Munich with its "Hendl". On top of that there is a roof terrace, which invites you to stay..

↖ *tasty chicken!*

Another great place is the "**Cooperativa**". This is a neighborhood restaurant that combines oriental cuisine with Bavarian tavern tradition. There you will most likely come into contact with locals, as there are no reservations and you take a seat where there is still room. Just say "ruck a stuck", which means "move a piece" and you'll be right in the middle of it instead of just there.

A hot tip for delicious cake and coffee is the **Café at Beethoven Platz (Mariandl)**, which offers you peace, joy and pancakes!

↖ *"Oans, Zwoa, Drei - gsuffa" - which means one, two, three - drink!*

Nearby is the **Bar Gabanyi**, which makes our favourite cocktails.

If you also have a sweet tooth, then why not give yourself a scoop - ice cream of course! :-D Taste delicious ice cream creations in the **Jessas Eisdiele in the Glockenbachviertel**. If you look for mountains in Munich, we won't blame you for the "black Peter", but rather call you the "**old Peter**", who gives you a wide view of the Alps. Alternatively, the **Café Vorhölzer** is one of the special kind from where you have a far view over Munich.

- **KZ-Gedänkstätte Dachau**



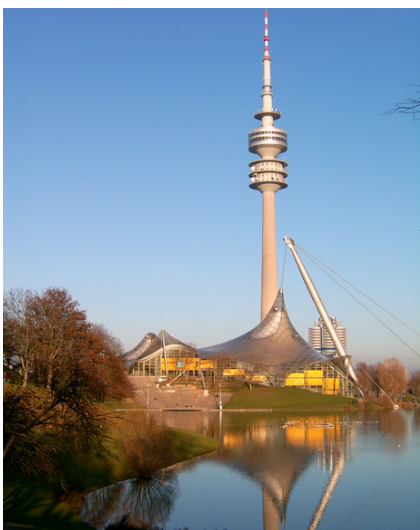
"A real Munich experience includes a short stop in a traditional brewery.
