EVERYTHING ABOUT THE APARTMENT

GENERAL INFORMATION

Welcome to my home! I am pleased to welcome you and I hope you enjoy your time in Munich. Please feel free to let me know if you need anything or if you have any concerns. Basic amenities have been provided including clean bedding, fresh towels, bathroom supplies, and more. You also have full access to our washer in the kitchen if you need to do laundry. There is a Nespresso coffee machine for your usage. Please consider that our home is a non-smoking environment. If you need to smoke, we kindly ask you to do so outside and to dispose your cigarettes afterwards.

WiFi/ Entertaining systems  *Take a break!*  *Think about Greta :)*

Our home has high-speed Internet access that you may connect to via wireless. The SSID is “**Christoph**” and the password is **55641077109139119449**. If you have any trouble connecting, try to switch the modem on/off. You find the modem in the narrow kitchen storage.

You can watch Netflix on the TV or other programs via the smart TV with access to internet. You are more than welcome to use our account to watch movies and TV shows during your stay. Alternatively, you might want to use the beamer in combination with the XBOX (press the start button on the white beamer. Then start the XBOX. Choose the “Airbnb” profile and watch whatever movie you like. You find a more detailed information on the XBOX). For the sound, there is a Bluetooth Box which you can also connect it to your mobile device to listen to your music. Just press the left button with the Bluetooth sign and connect the JBL box on your mobile device.


Washing machine

You find the detergents in the cupboard next to the oven. Use one cap per washing and fill it in the left compartment. The washer is easy to use: just choose „Mix“ for a sensor-based washing program. There is an iron below the sink and an ironing board behind the curtain in the kitchen as well as a clothes drying rack.

Parking

Parking on the street outside is possible and costs 6 € per day. The parking in the court- yard is unfortunately not possible. Otherwise, also use the nearest Park & Ride places: Underground parking Heimeranplatz or the City Parking Münchner Freiheit.

There is a last thing I would like to ask you for: please consider the neighbors after 22 p.m. (music/party volume) to let us keep up the harmonic relationship with our neighbors.

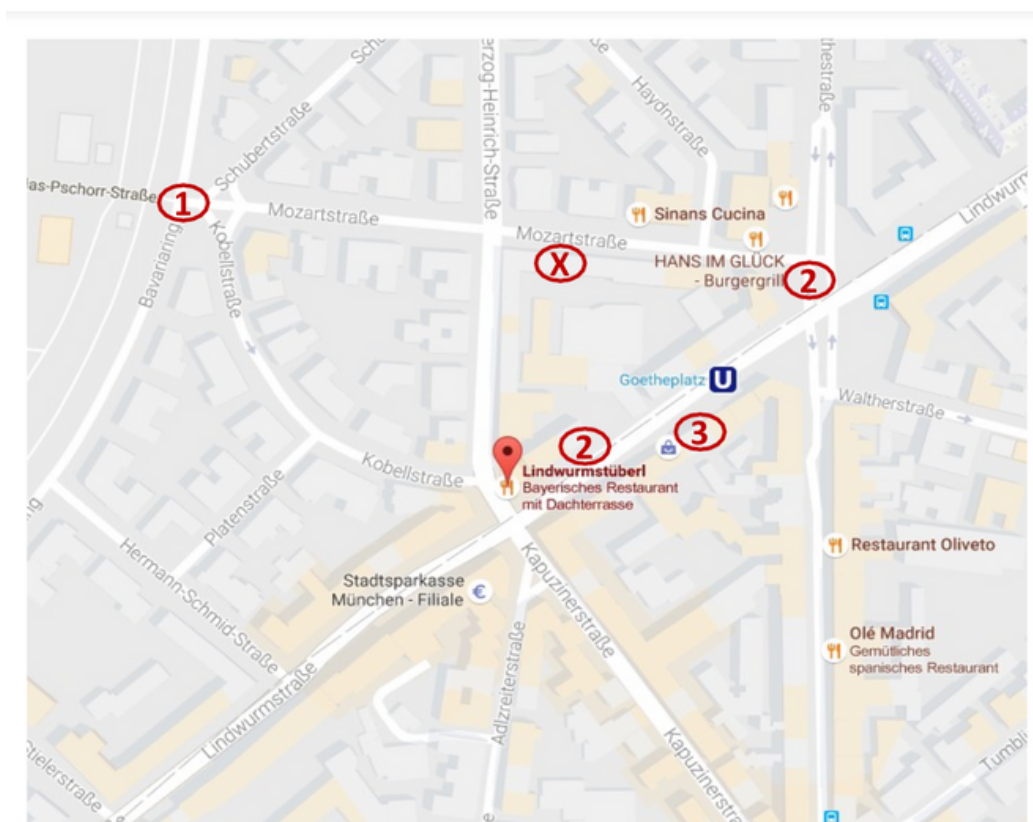
EVERYTHING IS CLOSE BY

BEST CONNECTION

Whether train, bus or subway, from our apartment all public transport is in the immediate vicinity. The fastest way to get to the city center is to take the subway from Goetheplatz.

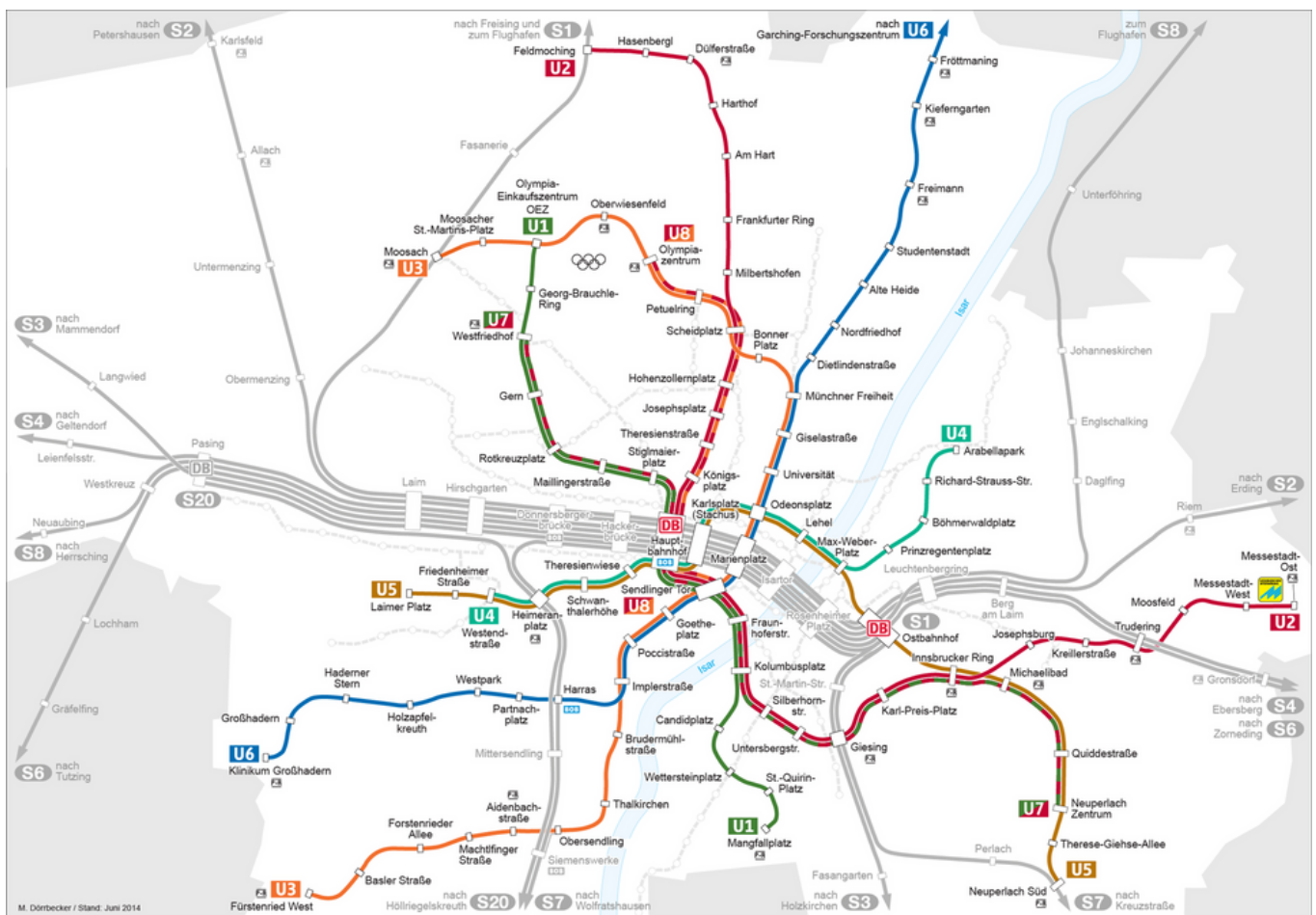
If you have to go to the main station, it is best to take the subway and change to the U3 or U2 at Sendlinger Tor. If you have a little more time, then the main station is even within 20 minutes walking distance (along the Theresienwiese).

The people of Munich like to ride their bikes! Download the MVGO app and use one of 4,500 bikes. Just go to an MVG bike station and rent an MVG bike (5 cents per minute).

FOOD & DRINKS

If you're a foodie and want to explore the Bavarian palate, then let's go to the "**Lindwurmstüberl**", which has made a name for itself in Munich with its "Hendl". On top of that there is a roof terrace, which invites you to stay..

↪ *tasty chicken!*

Another great place is the "**Cooperativa**". This is a neighborhood restaurant that combines oriental cuisine with Bavarian tavern tradition. There you will most likely come into contact with locals, as there are no reservations and you take a seat where there is still room. Just say "ruck a stuck", which means "move a piece" and you'll be right in the middle of it instead of just there.

A hot tip for delicious cake and coffee is the **Café at Beethoven Platz (Mariandl)**, which offers you peace, joy and pancakes!

↪ *"Oans, Zwoa, Drei - gsuffa" - which means one, two, three - drink!*

Nearby is the **Bar Gabanyi**, which makes our favourite cocktails.

If you also have a sweet tooth, then why not give yourself a scoop - ice cream of course! :-D Taste delicious ice cream creations in the **Jessas Eisdiele in the Glockenbachviertel**. If you look for mountains in Munich, we won't blame you for the "black Peter", but rather call you the "**old Peter**", who gives you a wide view of the Alps. Alternatively, the **Café Vorhölzer** is one of the special kind from where you have a far view over Munich.

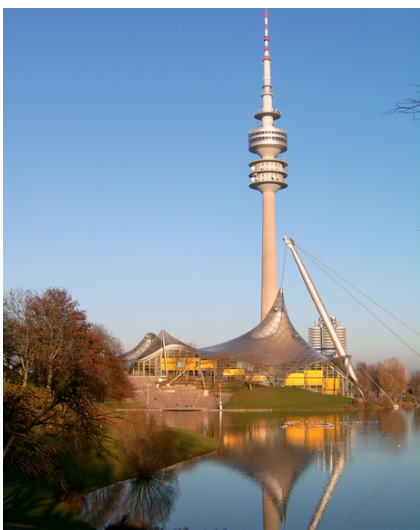
